Year 10 Enterprise Day – Tuesday 15th July 2014

As part of the school's commitment to providing relevant Careers Education and Guidance for students at St Margaret's, there will be a Year 10 Enterprise Day on **Tuesday 15th July 2014**. The aim of the day is to develop skills such as communication, team work, problem solving and to gain a greater insight into some of the career opportunities available to them, both locally and nationally. Through the help of Liverpool Compact, several employers have agreed to provide interactive workshops and presentations to achieve the aim.
