AS Fieldwork – Geography Enquiries based at Loggerheads North Wales

Year 12 students will be involved in a fieldwork course on Wednesday 3rd May 2017 as part of their AS studies. They will undertake work preparing them for the AS examination. Fieldwork and follow-up work will involve sampling methods, data collection, statistical analysis and the presentation and interpretation of findings.

The group will leave school after registration and return around 4.30 p.m. Students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and clothing should be suitable for work outdoors as data collection will go ahead in spite of rain. Clothing should include sturdy shoes or walking boots and waterproof jacket and trousers.

The prime consideration of fieldwork leaders is always the safety of the individual and the overall safety of the party and any decisions made or disciplinary action taken is to that end. On such outings we are all representatives of the school and the appropriate behaviour is expected. All the usual precautions and considerations regarding weather and location will be taken to ensure the safety of the party.
