You child has been chosen to participate in a short cookery course called 'Yes Chef'. The course will be delivered by Robin and Peter (the chef) from Scripture Union in three 1½ hours sessions commencing Thursday 16th March 2017.

This course is designed to help motivate, support and guide young people in the choices that they make and the consequences of these choices, whilst learning new cookery skills.

Scripture Union volunteer Peter got involved with crime for the first time aged just 10, committing a robbery with a gang in Toxteth, Liverpool. It was to be the start of more than two decades of criminal behaviour and gang violence. It was in a drug rehab centre during one of his prison sentences that Peter first came into contact with Christians. But it was an Alpha course whilst on remand as a "Category A" prisoner, that started him on a path towards repentance and transformation. Now married with two young children, and a trained chef, Peter has developed a project he calls 'The Yes Chef Experience' – short cookery courses in schools around Merseyside, working with small groups, passing on cookery skills and exploring the whole area of choices and consequences with teenagers.
