During the evening, you will be requested to sign in at the event. You will also be signing to say that you have collected a USB for your son. On the USB, there is an array of revision material from each subject area to support your son in the forthcoming GCSE examinations. The USB pens have been generously contributed to by St Margaret's Parents' Association.

We hope that all parents will have completed their appointments by 6.45 p.m, when a bell will ring to signal the end of the consultation evening.

Parental attendance at the consultations is excellent (normally over 96%) and we hope to maintain, if not better, these figures in years to come.
