Acceptable Shoes Policy

St Margaret's Church Of England Academy's Uniform Code requires all students to wear *solid*, *black*, *fully enclosed*, *safe*, *shoes*. Parents need to be aware that there is an important Occupational Health & Safety aspect regarding the shoes your child wears at school. The school is not prepared to breach Department of Education policy.

This has been liberally interpreted over the years to include many different styles of shoe. Plimsolls, Hybrid shoes such as 'Bamboo', 'Converse' and 'Vans', Canvas Shoes, Shoes with Logos and other embroidery **must not be worn**.

In failing to adhere to this policy, a student may be given the opportunity to wear school shoes purchased by the school. Alternative footwear will only be permitted during practical activity or on medical grounds
